

# THE BIRDS OF JACKSON BOTTOM CHECKLIST

## Seasons

- Sp - Spring: March through May  
 S - Summer: June through August  
 F - Fall: September through November  
 W - Winter: December through February

## Abundance (in normal habitat)

- c - common: usually seen on most visits  
 u - uncommon: usually seen on less than half of your visits  
 o - occasional: usually seen on less than 15 percent of visits  
 r - rare: usually only a few seen each year or not present every year

## Normal Habitats (Ha)

- F - Fields  
 M - Marsh  
 R - Riparian Woodland  
 S - Shoreline  
 W - Open Water  
 OW - Oak Woodland  
 CW - Coniferous Woodland
